

# IEPCP Partnership Evaluation 2016

## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

### INTRODUCTION:

In 2015-6 Inner East PCP offered a range of professional development opportunities. Some were hosted entirely by IEPCP and others were collaboratively planned and delivered. The following is a summary of the reach of the training program and the evaluation of those sessions by participants.

It is also recognised that the Inner East PCP collaborates extensively with other organisations to support forums and training across priority areas in the EMR. The following evaluation summary is concerned only with capacity building activity either fully organised by the Inner East PCP or in which we were a key partner.

When collating this information it was noted that a limitation on evaluation of the training program is the variability of evaluation questionnaires. Future action could include the development of a standardised, consistent, evaluation form for participants of workshops, training and conferences.

#### **Your Shout! Action on Alcohol:**

*(in collaboration with the Action on Alcohol Flagship group)*

- Attendees learned about the links between alcohol and violence, the challenges for local government, what the data can tell them, and potential ways forward.

#### **Dementia Diagnosis:**

- Participants appreciated the comprehensive information about dementia and impact, referral pathways, and diagnosis and the use of diagnostic tools.
- I have 'increased awareness of resources and services'
- I 'will reflect more on the type of Dementia diagnoses when thinking about supports and interventions'
- I will 'provide support to other team members in order to identify needs to diagnose Dementia'
